

2018 Augusta Caddy For A Cure Prediction Contest Rules / Term & Conditions

- 1) For the purpose of this contest, a **maximum of one thousand (1,000) attempts** will be submitted to Advantage Hole In One prior to the designated contest dates, and prior to the start of the designated game. Each contestant will be allowed to submit an entry with their prediction of the order of finish (Top 5, in order) of the designated game. The entry period will end on April 4, 2018 at 11:59 pm. The grand prize will be awarded to a contestant **whose submitted prediction matches exactly with the actual final order of finish, the top 5 and in order.** There shall be a **maximum of up to one (1) grand prize winner** covered by this contract. In the event of a tie, the "\$25,000 to the Winner" will be split evenly between the winners.
- 2) Each eligible entry must include the contestant's first and last name, email address and their prediction of five (5) players listed by number, in order from 1 to 5. Number 1 represents "1st Place"; Number 2 represents "2nd Place", and so on in order until 5th place. Once the contestant hits "submit" on the entry page, their entry is final and no changes can be made to their entry, including their player selections.
- 3) Multiple entries are permitted per contestant. The contestant can only win the grand prize once (in other words, if they enter the same prediction twice and win, they would ONLY win the \$25,000, it would not double if they had 2 entries correct).
- 4) **Once the entry period has ended, the following procedure will take place:**
 - a. Promptly as of 11:59 pm EST, the registration page will no longer accept entries, or if (1,000) entries is reached first.
 - b. Advantage Hole In One will be responsible for pulling the spreadsheet data of all entry submissions from the online registration page and a copy will be provided to the following persons: russ@caddyforacure.com
 - c. When the designated game is completed, the Advantage Hole In One representative will compare the prediction entries received with the actual order of finish for the designated game to determine if there has been a winning entry submitted.
 - d. In the event that there is a tie among golf players in the Top 5, the player(s) with the better Official World Golf Ranking at the start of the designated event (available at www.owgr.com) will be deemed the winner and thus break such tie(s). For example: If the following three (3) players are tied for 5th place: Player A, Player B and Player C; then the Player with the highest World Ranking would be deemed the 5th place finisher for purposes of the contest.
- 5) If any entry is not received by Advantage Hole In One by the start of the designated game, that contestant's entry will be disqualified, and no claim acknowledged for that entry.
- 6) **Any winning contestant will be required to produce sufficient identification. The name on the identification must match exactly with the name on the original prediction entry. This contestant must be the participant who originally submitted the prediction entry. No family members, friends or any other person will be allowed to accept the prize for winning contestant.**
- 7) **All predictions are clearly marked showing the order of finish, 1st through 5th place.**
- 8) **The contest supervisor (Caddy For A Cure) must make sure that all contestants are fully aware of all terms and conditions** outlined herein. All parties must understand that in the event of a claim, a polygraph test (at the expense of the sponsor) given by a professional polygraphist may be required of anyone involved in this promotion.
